CARLE PLACE

The LIRR Expansion Project from Floral Park to Hicksville, one of the region's most significant transportation infrastructure projects, is now underway throughout the communities along a nearly ten mile stretch of mainline track.

During the remainder of the month of July, you will see construction crews performing work in Carle Place. Specifically, there will be crews ensuring that any disturbed rodents and pests are controlled; and conducting pre-construction inspections of the existing conditions of structures surrounding worksites. By way of explanation:

Rodent and Pest Control

- Clearing and preparing property for construction may cause the natural habitat of some rodents and other pests to be disturbed
- We are aware of this and are taking all of the necessary steps to minimize any impacts this may have on you or adjacent LIRR property
- We will deliver effective rodent and pest control, while at the same time minimizing the volume and toxicity of pesticides used by incorporating tamper-proof stations that limits any pesticides used to inside the stations
- Control techniques include a combination of pest monitoring, good sanitation practices, education, appropriate solid waste management, and the use of pesticides, when warranted, according to application techniques

Existing Structure Surveys

- Property located within a specified radius of anticipated construction work requires a pre-construction photo inspection
- The survey is conducted to ensure the property is protected in the unlikely event of any damage
- Vibranalysis Inc., an independent consulting firm, will perform the survey
- Inspection consists of photographs and written documentation, recording the existing conditions of the interiors and exteriors of the structures surrounding the site

Neil Vincelette, who passed away on June 27th, was the Carle Place School District's first Business Department chairman and the first tennis coach for both the boys' and girls' teams, which he founded.

Neil was known to his Carle Place students, teachers, parents and friends for always showing a display of true kindness. The dedication and care he showed for his students and athletes was displayed for over 40 years. He was also a college professor for 20 years. He was a "one of a kind" leader in our Carle Place Schools and community and his legacy is still felt in our schools and community today.

Evelyn Bergwall also passed away recently. Evelyn was the district's ESL teacher, but the last years of her tenure were spent in the Rushmore school. She was known as more than a teachers to the students in her classes, as she provided a transition not only into our language, but to our community, culture and

country as well. She helped her students and their families -- who were speaking English as their second language and experiencing our community and culture for the first time -- deal with their total American immersion,. Her commitment, care and concern for them went well beyond classroom lessons. Moreover, she was inspirational for their life lessons as well. She was a beacon of light to them as they faced the challenge of adjusting to our American ways. Her students not only met the challenges of assimilation, but became leaders in our schools and society as well.

Beginning the 103rd year of our school district is a reminder that we face challenges today in our schools and community that may be different from those that were faced here in 1915, but the resolve we show, and the commitment, care and concern we apply, is at the heart of our children's success now, just as in 1915.

Back then, the First World War was devastating Europe and millions were being killed, but the U.S. had not yet entered the war. Kiwanis International was started in Detroit. The Women's International Conference was held, yet American women had not yet been granted the right to vote. And the immortal "Babe" Ruth hit his first homerun.

Our challenges in our school and community may be different, and the dangers to and safety of children in this "modern" age may be more serious concerns, but our vigilance is up to the task. Better schools and better communities are an incubator for the art of parenting, teaching and nurturing of children. They provide children with the opportunity to be all that they can be once they leave the nest. Pablo Picasso once said "Every child is an artist. The challenge is how to remain an artist once they grow up." Have a great year!

EYE OF THE HURRICANE

It may not be by accident that you just started reading this article about a new book called *When God Winks at You*. What brought me to this book was remembering my family, friends, and neighbors from the last 76 years in situations that just could not be random coincidence. I have suspected all along that there is more to coincidence than meets the "eye." What might have appeared to be isolated events seemed to me to be signposts pointing my way to a successful navigation of life, community, relationships, and interests. The author, Squire Rushnell, shows that by recognizing our "God Winks," we can recognize, in "coincidence," the presence in our lives of the influence of family, friends, colleagues, employers -- in fact, the way the passage of our lives and the weaving of interconnections bring meaning to our journey on this earth.

Author Rushness applies his compelling theory of what coincidences really are -- times when God winks at us -- to fascinating stories in history, sports, medicine, and relationships involving both everyday folks and famous people, including Barbra Streisand, Charles Schulz, Oprah Winfrey, Kevin Costner, Mark Twain, and Presidents John Adams and Thomas Jefferson.

One of the families was selling their house to the other. At the closing, the title closer noticed the name of the purchaser and told this story: As a child, she adored her grandfather, and loved going to his summer home in Dingman's Ferry, Pennsylvania. There she spent joyous childhood summers of fun, family, friendship and love with her beloved grandfather and her family in an idyllic setting, in nature's arms -- so much so that she revisited Dingman's Ferry after her grandfather's passing, only to find that the magical cottage of those childhood summers had been sold to a person with the same last name as the purchaser who was now buying a home in Carle Place.

When the purchaser arrived, the title closer told the story of those summers -- and our Carle Place purchaser stated that the new owner of the Dingman's Ferry cottage, was in fact his own father, had spent

his youth loving that summer house in Dingman's Ferry!

The title closer begged the purchaser, "Please tell your father that if he ever wants to sell the cottage, I would buy it in a second." Hey, you never know?! But what we do know is that this closing could have taken place anywhere on Long Island. It could have taken place with any title closer in the greater metropolitan area. FILLING YOU IN

Tonsil Stones

Did you know that the kidneys aren't the only place in your body to develop stones? Most people don't know that tonsils may also have stones. In fact, many people who have tonsil stones don't even realize it.


Also known as tonsilloliths, tonsilliths, and tonsil calculi, tonsil stones are the small calcified (hardened) masses of food particles, mucus, bacteria and other debris that accumulate in the crypts of the tonsils. The crypts are the folds or pockets naturally found in your tonsils.

Tonsil stones are white or yellow and vary in size. They can be as small as a sesame seed or as large as a pumpkin seed. While they are benign, usually painless and most people are unaware of their presence, they can cause the tonsils to become enlarged and inflamed, making it difficult to swallow and causing bad breath.

Tonsil stones are caused by the accumulation of debris and bacteria in the tonsil crypts that harden over time. Other things that contribute to the formation of these stones include prescription drugs, dry mouth, and sinus or allergy problems. Any medication that reduces the salivary flow will contribute to stone formation because saliva contains various electrolytes, enzymes, and antibacterial compounds that destroy harmful bacteria in the mouth. Sinus problems or allergies lead to post nasal drip and a build up of mucus.

Symptoms of tonsil stones include white or yellow debris, ear pain, swollen tonsils, bad breath, sore throat, difficulty swallowing, excessive coughing and a bad taste in the mouth. While they are not life threatening, they can be annoying. Simply applying gentle pressure on the tonsils with a cotton swab will dislodge the stones; however, sometimes they dislodge when coughing or sneezing.

Prevention is as simple as good oral hygiene. Brushing teeth and tongue after meals, at bedtime, first thing in the morning, and flossing daily help to reduce the amount of bacteria in your mouth. Gargling daily with antibacterial mouthwashes that do not contain alcohol or using a homemade solution of hydrogen peroxide and water is also very helpful.
